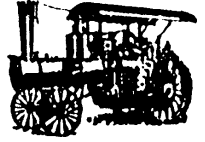

TRACTOR PULL CLASSES

Weight Classes (lbs)

- **Stock 40 years old and older:** 3500, 4000, 4500, 5000, 5500, 6000, 6500, 7500, 8500, 9500. MAX 4 MPH
- **Improved:** 4000, 4500, 5000, 5500, 6000, 6500. MAX 6 MPH. No tire regs.
- **Out of the Field:** 7500, 8500, 9500, 10500 MAX 6 MPH. No tire regs.
- **Open Class:** 4500, 5000, 5500, 6000, 6500.
- **V8:** 4500, 5500.
- **KING OF THE HILL** - Stock class tractors: 4500, 6500

***ALL CLASSES HAVE A 100 LBS. OVERWEIGHT ALLOWANCE ***

Trophies will be awarded at the end of a class

Safety is everyone's obligation. Operators observed in unsafe practices may be asked to leave the show-site.

TRACTOR PULL RULES

- Entry Fee

- An entry fee* of \$20 for each hook is to be paid at the time of registration. If you decide to pull more than planned, more hooks can be added at the registration table for the same \$20 fee. All entries after 7pm on day of pull will be assessed a \$10 late fee.
- **EACH TRACTOR CAN HOOK NO MORE THAN 3 TIMES.** This rule is subject to change based on puller attendance, but to keep the pull moving smoothly, a hook limit has been implemented.
- *Disclaimer: the entry fee is non-refundable EXCEPT if the pull is canceled for uncontrollable reasons (weather, track or pulling skid emergency, etc.).

- Drawbar

Drawbar maximum height is to be 20" and a minimum of 18" from the center of the rear axle to the hook point of the drawbar. Drawbar must have a minimum hole size of 3/4" or a 3" opening able to receive a hook, not more than 2" forward of the rear of the drawbar. Drawbar must be stationary in all directions.

- Tires

Radial tires are allowed. Groomed tires are only allowed in 6mph **OPEN** and **V8** classes.

- 3500-4500: 13.6x38, 14.9x28
- 5000-6500: 14.9x38, 15.5x38, 18.9x34
- 7000-7500: 16.9x38, 18.4x28, 18.4x38
- 6mph classes have no tire regulations.

- King of the Hill

- Stock class tractors will be allowed to hook in this class. These hooks do not count towards the 3 hook limit. 3000 RPM max. No speed limit.

- Stock Class

Stock class tractors should appear stock with factory made block intake and carburetor, working governor, no side shields, 20% over on factory RPM's, 3000 RPM max.

- Weights

No weights shall be placed more than 11' forward of the center of the rear axle of the tractor.

- Hook-up and Un-hook

Tractors must be placed in neutral when hooking up and unhooking from the sled.

- **Speed Limit Horn Rules**
Shall the speed limit horn on the pulling skid sound 2 TIMES, you will be automatically disqualified.
- **Judges**
The track judges will final decision in all rules and regulations of the pull.
- **Entrant Qualification**
Contestants enter at their own risk. A waiver must be signed before your hook.
- **Termination of Pull**
The pull is terminated when the forward motion of the tractor stops.
- **No Re-Pull**
You will be given two attempts to take off.
- **Equipment Required**
Open and V8 class tractors must have a kill switch that can hook to the pulling sled, 3000 RPM max,
- **Equipment Not Allowed**
 - **All classes**, Dual tires, fuel injection or gas under pressure unless factory equipped.
 - **Stock Class**, no turbo chargers will be allowed, a working governor is mandatory, no cut tires will be allowed.
- **Age Requirement**
Any person under the age of 18 must have parent or legal guardian present during registration and provide written consent for child to pull a tractor.
- **Safety**
Pullers MUST drive at a safe speed both during and after a pull. No consumption of alcohol before or during the pull by pullers is allowed. Violators of these rules are subject to ejection from the pull.
